No. 2—Resolved, that as a district we are in favor of our manual being made more definite and specific on the divorce question.

### Resolutions Committee Report

The Resolutions Committee reported and the following resolutions were adopted by the Assembly.

#### Resolution Number 1:

Resolved that each local church of the district be assessed to the minimum of \$3.00 per adult member to help finance the District expense fund and that one-half of said amount be paid in on or before Jan. 1, 1931.

#### Resolution Number 2:

Resolved that a special service be held and a cash and pledge offering be taken for Home Missions during the District Camp Meeting, and that each local church in the district hold a Home Missionary service and take a special offering at least twice during the conference year.

#### Resolution Number 3:

Resolved that a copy of these resolutions be placed in the hands of each Pilgrim Holiness family and minister of this district.

#### Resolution Number 4:

Resolved that the District Superintendent make two visits annually to each local church unless conditions require more and that a special offering be raised for his support at the time of his visit.

**Resolution Number 5:**

Resolved that all ministers of the district pay their ministerial tithes to the support of the District Superintendent.

**Resolution Number 6:**

Resolved that the District Superintendent pay two-thirds of his ministerial tithe into the district treasury.

**Resolution Number 7:**

Resolved that the sum of \$50.00 per year be paid to the District Superintendent toward the upkeep of his car.

**Resolution Number 8:**

Resolved that the District Superintendent should draw upon the district treasury for traveling expenses incurred in the interests of the district, other than his regular visits to the churches.

**Resolution Number 9:**

Resolved that \$15.00 per month be paid the District Superintendent for house rent.

**Resolution Number 10:**

Resolved that every member of the Assembly be requested to attend the Assembly sessions or furnish a legitimate excuse in writing.

**Resolution Number 11:**

In as much as God in His all-wise providence has deemed it best to call home from our midst our most dearly beloved brother, C. R. Simmons, be it therefore resolved that we show our appreciation for his untiring labor and loyalty to the church by a rising vote.

**Resolution Number 12:**

Resolved that the District Superintendent visit all independent churches and missions on the district which are supplied by ministers who are members of this Assembly.

**Resolution Number 13:**

Resolved that all monies or receipts for monies sent to the different departments of the general church, be given to the local church treasurer and then to district treasurer in order that our financial records shall be complete.

**Report of Examining Board**

Recommend Mrs. Opal Webster, who now holds licensed Deaconess credentials, be ordained as a Deaconess.

Motion made and carried that Mrs. Opal Webster be accepted for ordination as Deaconess.
