The nineteenth annual district assembly of the Idaho-Washington District, of Pilgrim Holiness Church, convened at the Coeur d'Alene Church on July 31st, 1933. The meeting was called to order at 9 o'clock by General Superintendent W. L. Surbrook in the chair. Devotions were opened by singing "I need Thee every hour" and "Love Divine". We were lead in prayer by Sister Scott and Brother Goss, singing "Near the Cross" on our knees. Bro. Surbrook read from Phil. 2:1-16, then gave us a talk on conditions in the church; he said in part: "Altho salaries have been cut to the bone, we are making a good advancement spiritually and numerically at home and on the foreign fields, we are 2000 members stronger since last General Assembly. We have a loyal bunch of folks for which we praise God".

### Roll Call

The roll of Assembly members was prepared and called.  
Minutes of the last Assembly sitting were read and approved.

### Assembly Bar

Motion was made that the Assembly Bar consist of the seats in the middle section of the church. Motion carried.

### Time of Sessions

Motion was made that the Assembly sessions begin at 9 o'clock a. m. and close at 11:45, begin at 1:30 p. m. and close at 4:30.

### Reports of Pastors and Churches

Rev. Doll of Spirit Lake and Athol Churches reported. His report was accepted

Bro. George Clark, Delegate from Athol Church, read church and Sunday School reports. Reports accepted.

Sister Koethke, Delegate, read the Church and Sunday School reports from Spirit Lake Church. Reports accepted.

Rev. Horning reported. He has been preaching in Eatonville, Washington, for the past three years. His report was accepted.

Sister Garner gave in her report. She has been preaching part of the year at Mt. Hope. Report was accepted.

Rev. C. C. Calhoon reported. Report accepted.

Sister Calhoon reported. Altho there have been trials God has enabled her to keep the victory. To God be all the glory.

Rev. Goss reported with victory. Report accepted.

Sister Fullerton reports from McGuire's Church and Sunday School. Reports accepted.

Sister Scott reports a good year and some souls saved. Her report accepted.

Rev. Webster gives in a good report with some gains in church work. His report accepted.

Sister Mann reports for the Coeur d'Alene Sunday School and Church. Reports accepted.

Bro. Stultz sent in a written report which was read by the secretary, asking for a letter of transfer. His report was received.

Adjournment by pressure of time.

### Second Session

The second session of the Annual Assembly was called to order at 1:30 p. m. Devotions were opened by singing "Bringing in the Sheaves". We were lead in prayer by Rev. Webster.

Brother and Sister Himmelright and Brother and Sister Philo were granted a seat in assembly bar.

Hazel L. Goss reported having held two revival meetings and taking part in the third. Altho there have been reverses it has been a good year. Her report was accepted.

Sister Webster reported a good year leading the singing in many services, distributing garments, calling, and assisting her husband in many ways. Her report was accepted.

Rev. W. J. Webster gave in the following report as Superintendent:

The resolutions committee reported and the following resolutions were adopted:

**Resolution No. 1:** Resolved, That each local church of the district be apportioned the minimum of \$5.00 per member to finance our general church and district obligations, said amount to be distributed as follows: Foreign Missions 40%, Home Missions 20%, District Expense 20%, General budget 20%.

**Resolution No. 2:** Resolved, That 125 copies of the District Minutes be printed and one copy placed in the hands of each Pilgrim Holiness family and minister of this District, and that 5 copies be mailed to the General Office, and one to each District Superintendent.

**Resolution No. 3:** Resolved, That \$50.00 be paid to our District Superintendent from our District Treasury. This amount to be paid in quarterly installments, also that special offerings be taken at each quarterly meeting.

**Resolution No. 4:** Resolved, That the District Superintendent draw upon the District Treasury for traveling expenses incurred in the interest of the District.

**Resolution No. 5:** Resolved, That the District Superintendent visit all independent churches and missions of the District which are supplied by ministers who are members of this assembly if possible.

**Resolution No. 6:** Resolved, That all monies or receipts for monies sent to the different departments of the general church be given to the local church treasurer and then forwarded to District Treasurer in order that our financial records shall be complete.

**Resolution No. 7:** Resolved, That our District Superintendent shall have supervision over the home Missionary work of the church.

**Resolution No. 8:** Resolved, That we have two District Group meetings each year and that the time and place be left to the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent.

**Resolution No. 9:** Resolved, That the Camp-meeting committee consist of three members and that they be empowered to transact all business relative to the Camp-meeting, conferring with the District Council when necessary.

**Resolution No. 10:** Resolved, That the District Superintendent appoint the Statistical Committee two weeks prior to the assembly, and that the Superintendent send two blank reports to each minister, church, and Sunday school, and that these be filled out and one copy sent to the committee not less than 10 days prior to the Assembly, the other to be retained and read on the floor of the Assembly.

**Resolution No. 11:** Resolved, That each church of our District set one prayer-meeting night during each month as a special time for donations to the pastor and family; such to be announced by one of the deacons at a previous service.

**Resolution No. 12:** Be Resolved, That we as an Assembly give a rising vote of thanks to our General Superintendent, Brother Surlbrook, and wife for coming to us in this time of need when other calls were so urgent. His ability and judgment have certainly been an asset to our Assembly and his messages, talks and advice have been unquestionably sound and sensible. We urge his return to us if Jesus tarries.

The Statistical committee reports. Report accepted.  
Motion made and supported that the Montesano Mission be received into the District. Carried.

Adjourned until Wednesday 9 o'clock.

### Third Session

Session opened by singing "I need Thee every hour". Brother Surbrook read from Romans, 12th chapter. Led in prayer by Brother Philo. Roll was called. Minutes of last sitting were read and approved.

Auditing Committee gave the following report: The District Treasurer's books were audited this 31st day of July, 1933, and were found to be correct and in good order. L. W. Goss and G. W. Clark. Report accepted.

The District Treasurer's report was read and accepted.

### Report of District Examining Board

The Examining Board gave the following report: We, the District Examining Board, recommend that this Assembly receive Rev. and Mrs. L. C. Philo and that his name be placed on the roll of ordained ministers subject to his transfer from the Michigan District. Accepted.

Recommended that Dorthea Calhoon be granted renewal of license and that she be advanced to the third year course of study for licensed ministers. Accepted. That J. B. Bush be granted renewal of license and retained in the first year course of study. Accepted. We recommend that this Assembly receive the transfer of membership of Rev. and Mrs. E. R. Himmelright from the Rocky Mountain District and that his name be placed on the roll of ordained ministers, and her name on the roll of deaconesses.

A motion was made to postpone taking Bro. and Sister Himmelright into the Idaho-Washington District at his request, and that the District Council be impowered to take action. Motion carried.

Hazel L. Goss appeared before the District Examining Board, passed a satisfactory examination and we recommend her to this Assembly for ordination.
