JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS

The 1961 Conference of the South Carolina-Georgia District convened at 9 o'clock a.m. at the Reunion School, Easley, South Carolina. Rev. Maurice Schenck opened the Conference by leading in the singing of a hymn, "I Will Praise Him". Rev. Eversole led in prayer.

Rev. H. C. Rickner, District Superintendent, introduced Rev. R. C. Hawkins, General Secretary of Church Extension. Dr. Hawkins presented Dr. Melvin Snyder, General Superintendent of the Pilgrim Holiness Church to the Conference. Dr. Hawkins addressed the Conference using John 14:15 as the basis of his message.

The District Secretary called the roll.

The Conference bar was established. The first six rows of seats on the left side of the auditorium constituted the bar.

The motion carried that the time of sittings be 9 - 12 o'clock a.m., and 1 o'clock p.m. until the business was completed.

Rev. H. C. Rickner, District Superintendent, read his report. The report was accepted by a rising vote of thanks.

The following reports were read and accepted:

Treasurer	-	Rev. Howard Smith
Statistics	-	Mrs. Edith Smith

Rev. Homer Smith introduced Rev. Clyde Parker, pastor at Elkin, North Carolina. Rev. Parker is currently in a revival at Columbia, South Carolina. Rev. Parker was granted a seat with the Conference bar.

Rev. Frank Hopkins, Sunday School District Secretary, read his report which was accepted.

Journal of Proceedings (Cont'd).

Rev. H. S. Mosser reported for the Examining and Educational Board. This report was accepted.

Rev. Howard Smith reported for the Ways and Means Committee. Resolution No. 1 page 11 of the 1960 Minutes was passed as amended. The word Sunday school was inserted and the United Stewardship Fund was raised to \$8.00. Dr. Snyder spoke on the meaning of paying budgets, district and general.

A 15 minute recess was declared. The Conference was led in the singing of a hymn, "Let The Beauty of Jesus Be Seen In Me". Rev. H. S. Mosser led in prayer.

Dr. Hawkins expressed his appreciation to those who prayed for Mrs. Hawkins during her serious illness.

Rev. Homer Smith reported for the Resolution Committee. The following resolution was read and accepted:

"Be it resolved that the Executive officers of the Atlantic Southeast

District of the Pilgrim Churches, Inc. constitute the District Trustees".

This resolution to be placed in the standing rules.

It was moved and carried that resolutions No. 8 and 9 on page 12 and No. 10 on page 13 of the 1960 Minutes be referred to the District Council with power to act.

The next order of business being the election of officers, Dr. Hawkins read the General Board appointments as follows:

Dr. Hawkins introduced Rev. and Mrs. T. M. Weir who gave words of greeting and personal testimonies. Rev. Rickner spoke in behalf of Rev. Weir.

Rev. Rickner appointed Rev. Clyde Parker and Rev. Maurice Schenck as tellers.

Ballots were cast and the following officers were elected:

Ballots were cast for ministerial delegate to the General Conference. It was moved and carried that the second highest be the alternate delegate.

Rev. Homer Smith was elected delegate and Rev. Frank Hopkins as the alternate.

Mr. Gilbert Koon was elected as lay delegate and Mr. Frank Grooms as alternate.

Rev. H. S. Mosser further reported for the Examining and Educational Board. Mr. Frank Grooms was granted first year liscense.

It was moved and carried that the Conference adjourn. Dr. Melvin Snyder dismissed with prayer.

## C O N F E R E N C E R U L E S

### Way and Means Resolutions

1. We reccommend that Standing Rule #8 page 14 of the 1960 Minutes read as follows:

The district budget shall be 10% of all the regular church and Sunday school offerings and that the United Stewardship Fund be \$8.00 per member as reccommended by the General Conference.

### District Resolutions

1. Be it resolved that the Executive officers of the Atlantic Southeast Conference Pilgrim Churches be the district trustees. This to be put in the Standing Rules.
2. Be it resolved that we give a rising vote of thanks to the cooks and helpers, Rev. J. D. Smith, Rev. H. C. Rickner, and Rev. R. C. Hawkins for their faithful services to the camp and conference throughout the year.



## STANDING RULES

1. Be it resolved that the conference year shall end May 31st and that all reports and funds shall be in the hands of the district statistician and district treasurer by June 15th. Be it further resolved that the record shall close June 30th and the annual conference shall be held the last Saturday of the camp meeting.
2. Be it resolved that the district superintendent shall appoint all committees.
3. Be it resolved that the district council shall serve as the camp meeting board and that they be responsible for engaging the camp workers. Be it further resolved that the place and date of the camp meeting and the names of the workers be placed in the Minutes each year.
4. Be it resolved that an annual Ministerial Convention be held, the time and place of said convention to be determined by the district council.
5. Be it resolved that each pastor make a monthly report of Sunday school attendance to the district Sunday school promotional secretary within five days following the last Sunday of the month. Be it further resolved that the secretary publish a news sheet showing attendance and news items of the Sunday school.
6. Be it resolved that each pastor be granted a two weeks vacation with pay.
7. Be it resolved that each local church set aside one day a week for fasting and prayer. Be it further resolved that we pray for the leadership of Holy Ghost in all matters and that we intercede for a revival in the churches of our district.
8. Be it resolved that the district budget shall be 10% of all regular church and Sunday school offerings. Be it further resolved that the United Stewardship Fund be \$8.00 per member as recommended by the General Conference.
9. It is recommended that the local church treasurers balance their books at the close of each month and that all district and general funds be sent to the district treasurer immediately.
10. It is recommended that all monies raised for the district and general interests shall be handled through the local and district treasurers.
11. Be it resolved that the executive officers of the Atlantic Southeast Conference Pilgrim Churches be the district trustees.
