Our General Secretary, Rev. P. W. Thomas then took charge as Chairman and meeting was called to order.

Moved and seconded that Resolution and Reception Committees be appointed by the Dist. Supt. Carried.

Moved and seconded that Flora church be received into the Assembly. Carried.

Moved and seconded that the Bridgeport church be received into the Assembly. Carried.

The District Supt. appointed on the Resolution Committee, Sister Meeks, chairman, Sister Roush and Sister Hanna.

On Reception Committee, Sister Catey.

Ways and Means Committee presented some recommendations, which were adopted.

Brothers A. O. Morgan and W. C. Beard were given seats in the Conference bar.

Adjourned with prayer to meet at 2:00 P. M.

AFTERNOON SITTING

Bro. Bradley led in singing, "When We All Get to Heaven." Bro. Meeks read the 103 Psalm and sang a verse of "Take Up Thy Cross and Follow Me."

Bro. Hanna led in prayer after which Bro. Thomas gave us some good advice and exhortation along lines of "Recognizing Central Authority of District Assembly."

Minutes of morning sitting were read and approved with slight correction.

Moved and seconded that reading of recommendations adopted be dispensed with. Carried.

Moved and seconded that Bro. Wm. Hall be granted a seat within the conference bar. Carried.

Moved and seconded that Bro. Abernathy be granted a seat within the conference bar. Carried.

Bro. R. S. Wheeldon's report was read and accepted.

The Auditing committee reported that Camp and Dist. Treasurers books had been audited and were correct.

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The Treasurer Bro. Geo. Smith then gave his report, which was accepted.

Moved and seconded that time of election of officers be set for 7:30 P. M. Carried.

Moved and seconded that the action pertaining to the 10c per week from the Sunday Schools be rescinded. Carried.

The Ways and Means committee presented more recommendations. Nos. 14, 15, 18, 19, 20, 21, 24, 25, 26, 29, 30, were adopted.

Moved and seconded that motion in reference to Dist. Funds be tabled until figures be presented giving needed information. Carried.

Moved and seconded that recommendation to have 300 copies of District minutes printed be referred back to the Committee. Carried.

The report of the District Superintendent was read and accepted.

Motion to adjourn was made and Assembly adjourned with prayer to meet at 7:00 P. M.

### NIGHT SITTING, AUGUST 27, 1934

Assembly was called to order by singing, "Marching to Zion." Roll was called. Prayer was offered by Bro. Catey. Promises from the Word were quoted by members of the Assembly. Minutes of the morning sitting were read and approved.

Reports of the Educational and Examining boards were read and accepted.

Bro. C. C. Breen's report was read and accepted. Election of officers was next in order and prayer was made that the Lord have His way.

Ways and Means: Motion was made and seconded that the District Council bring in nominations for Ways and Means Committee Carried.

Adjourned with prayer to meet at 8:30 Tuesday morning.

### MORNING SITTING, AUGUST 28, 1934

Assembly was called to order by Bro. Thomas, who read the Scripture lesson from 2nd Timothy 2nd chapter, preaching from the same stirring us along the line of evangelism and placing ourselves entirely at God's disposal. Prayer was offered for the District. Minutes were read and approved.

Bro. Geo. A. Smith handed in his resignation as District Treasurer which was accepted.

Tellers were appointed and the Assembly proceeded to elect a District Treasurer. Bro. Glen Neely of Charleston, Ill., was elected.

Moved and seconded that we accept the report of the District Council that we leave the Resolutions Committee and the Auditing Committee to be appointed at the next Assembly and that we dispense with the Statistical Committee since we have a District Statistician. Carried.

Report of O. A. Morgan was read and accepted. Moved and seconded that we pledge Bro. Morgan our Moral support as an Assembly. Carried.

Report of W. O. Beard was read and accepted.

Report of Ways and Means Committee which brought in recommendation for changes in article 2 section C as written. Accepted. Recommendation No. 22, was read and accepted.

Moved and seconded that the memorials be referred back to the District Council and Committee and that Bro. Thomas preside. Carried-

Report of the Resolution Committee was read and accepted. See report.

Ways and Means: Moved and seconded that the matter of expenses of delegates to General Assembly be turned to District Council and Committee to be decided by them. Carried.

Moved and seconded that time be extended. Carried.

Moved and seconded that all unfinished business be left to the District Council. Carried.

A partial report of the District Statistician was read.

Moved and seconded that Ministerial and Sunday School Convention be combined with the Annual Assembly and that the Meeting begin on the first Tuesday in June and continue over the following Sunday.

Motion made and seconded to table this matter. Carried.

Minutes were approved as read and the Assembly adjourned with prayer by Brother Catey.

## WAYS AND MEANS

## AS REVISED BY THE ANNUAL ASSEMBLY OF 1934

1. Since the General Assembly has adopted the Budget System of administering the finances of the General Church, we strongly urge all local Church Boards of this District to adopt the Budget System for administering the finances of their respective local Churches. Also that each pastor be paid a stipulated amount sufficient for his support, and that at the respective annual church meetings each church shall decide what financial support they will pay their pastor during the coming year.

2. The District Budget shall be raised and disbursed in the following manner:

A. An amount equal to fifteen per cent ( $\overline{15}\%$ ) of all funds received by each local church, including that received by each pastor for his services as such, and exclusive of all funds paid to the purchase, rental or necessary upkeep, of all real estate or buildings for church or parsonage uses, shall be set aside by the local church treasurer each Monday and remitted by him to the District Treasurer on the first of each month. ("Necessary upkeep" would not include money spent for furniture, furnishings, electric light bills, etc. It would include only money spent for anything actually necessary to the maintenance or preservation of the property such as paint, roofing, together with the cost of applying the same, special taxes, insurance premiums, payments on church debt, etc.)

B. Each ministerial and lay member of this district shall pay ten cents each month to their local treasurer, same to be forwarded on the first day of the succeeding month to the District Treasurer for the District Budget. (This assessment and all Foreign Missionary Funds are not subject to the  $\overline{15}\%$  tax since they are not raised as local funds.)

C. All funds received by the District Treasurer in fulfillment of requirements of paragraph A and B of this ruling, shall be divided by him as follows:

District Superintendents fund	$\overline{50}$ per cent.
Miscellaneous Dist. Expense fund	$\overline{20}$ per cent.
General Church Budget	$\overline{20}$ per cent.
Church Extension	$\overline{10}$ per cent.

D. A free will offering shall be taken by the pastors for the District Superintendent at the time of each of his regular or called visits to the respective churches, same to be applied by the Superintendent on his salary and expenses and the District be given due credit for the same.

3. Since the District Superintendent is to the District, what the pastor is to the Church, the Dist. Supt. shall meet with each local church board at the time of his visits and enquire carefully into the spiritual and financial condition of the church, and help them in the solution of their various problems.

4. The District Superintendent shall present the need of canned fruits, vegetables, meats, etc., for the District Camp Meeting, to each local church at least once during the year.

5. The District Superintendent shall arrange zone meetings of the pastors, and other ministers and officers, members of local churches, for the purpose of helping the churches put on the Budget System. The District Superintendent shall arrange the churches in zones as he deems best.

6. Each local Church shall pay into the Camp Meeting treasury, the sum of Five Dollars for each delegate elected to the Annual Assembly, said payment to provide entertainment of said delegate throughout the Camp and Assembly.

7. All of our preachers and lay members shall secure respectively, a copy of our church Manuel and the Minutes of this Assembly and shall read and study the same until they are able to understand and carry out all of their provisions and requirements.

8. Each church shall be responsible for one comforter for Camp Meeting purposes and the name of the donor shall be inscribed.

9. The deacons and deaconesses of each local church shall constitute a committee to secure regular monthly donations of foodstuffs, etc. for the Pastor's family, said donations to be brought to the parsonage by the donors at a given date and time.

10. Each pastor shall keep a record of all subscribers to the Advocate in each neighborhood or city where he pastors, and shall, about Thirty Days before each subscription expires, begin to endeavor to secure a renewal of the same.

Each pastor shall endeavor to secure a sufficient number of subscribers to the Advocate, in the communities where his preaching appointment is located, to cause the total number of subscribers in each community to be equal to 50% of members in the respective churches.

11. The revision of church membership rolls shall be made prior to the respective annual Church meetings.

12. Our people shall not send money direct to any of our General Church interests, but they shall remit to their own local treasurer who shall forward all of the same to the District Treasurer, who shall make disbursements to the proper General Interests.

13. The local churches shall accept and work the plan as suggested by the General Board, for increasing interest in Foreign Missions and for raising Foreign Missionary funds.

14. The regular Sunday School offering on One Sunday per month shall be a special offering for Foreign Missions and shall be forwarded to the District Treasurer for this purpose. The particular Sunday on which this offering shall be taken shall be determined by the Sunday School Board.

15. The District Secretary shall be paid Ten Dollars for editing the Minutes, and the District Treasurer shall be paid Ten Dollars per year for his services.

16. The District Superintendent, Assistant, and the District Secretary shall constitute a committee to have 200 copies of the District minutes printed, cost of same to be apportioned among the churches on the basis of cash paid to pastor during 1933-1934.

17. The District Superintendent is an Advisory member of all District Boards and Committees.

18. The Assembly year shall end with July 31st each year and all business transacted between that and the Annual Assembly, shall be included in the following years report. Also the Assembly year shall be divided as into four quarters, ending

with the following dates respectively: First quarter Aug. 1st to Oct. 31st. Second quarter Nov. 1st to Jan. 31st. Third quarter Feb. 1st to April 30th. Fourth quarter May 1st to July 31st. A quarterly meeting shall be held in each church within ten days following the close of each quarter, at which time reports covering the quarter shall be read. Said reports shall be copied in the church secretary's book and the original reports sent to the District Superintendent. Quarterly meetings shall be conducted by the pastors when the Dist. Supt. does not happen to be present. All annual reports shall be copied in the church secretary's book and mailed to the District Statistician immediately following the close of the Assembly Year, July 31.

19. The District Supt. and Dist. Secretary shall keep in touch with the pastors reminding them of the plans of this Assembly, and encourage and help them to carry out said plans.

20. This Assembly requires it's ministerial members to attend the Assembly and Camp Meeting (they shall be present on the first day and remain until the close.) Each church shall keep up the salary of it's pastor during Camp Meeting. If any minister does not attend, he shall send a report of his work and an excuse for his absence. If he fails to do so for two consecutive years he shall be disciplined.

21. The District Secretary shall notify in writing all the members of this Assembly who have failed to meet the requirements of the foregoing rule (No. 20) calling their attention to such failure and the penalty for the same, at least thirty days before our next Assembly.

22. The Church Extension work shall be left in the hands of the District Superintendent and District Council.

23. We recommend that 15% of all regular Camp Meeting offerings be placed in the District Budget.

24. The District Superintendent shall examine the records of the Secretary and Treasurer of each local Church at the time of his regular visits thereto and shall offer any needed suggestions as to how they may improve in the performance of their duties.

25. The District Superintendent shall review all of the District rules with each local Church Board at the time of each regular visit to the respective churches and shall give them any needed advice in carrying them out.

26. The District Treasurer shall furnish the District Superintendent with a detailed report following the close of each quarter, showing what each church has paid toward each item in the District and General Financial Program.

27. Each pastor shall maintain a calling list, using the card filing system which shall be the property of each succeeding pastor, and the expenses of the same shall be borne by the local church.
