## FIRST SITTING

The thirteenth annual conference of the Texas District of the Pilgrim Holiness Church convened on June 5, 1963, at 7:30 P.M., in the new church at Fort Worth. The pastor, Rev. Paul Scheuermeier, gave a few words of welcome and introduced Dr. R. C. Hawkins, chairman of the Conference, who in turn introduced Rev. R. T. Powell, our new District Superintendent. Brother Powell called for the Conference to stand and sing the doxology in praise to God for the beautiful church building, and then led the conference in singing number 265, "All Hail the Power". The second number was "He Brought Me Out." The pastor led in prayer.

The Central Pilgrim College quartet, from Bartlesville, Oklahoma, sang two special numbers that were very much appreciated and then the offering was received. The quartet again sang, "The Old Rugged Cross." Brother Powell presented Dr. Hawkins, who brought the message from Ecclesiastes 1:5-7, using as a theme, "Christianity and the River." The analogy of the Christian's life to the river was ably presented in a very forceful way. In closing, the conference delegates sang, "Amazing Grace."

## SECOND SITTING

The first business session of this conference was called to order, at 9 A.M., by Brother Powell, who requested that the delegates stand in silent prayer while Sister Powell played softly on the organ. Brother Powell then invoked God's presence on the conference. We were led in singing No. 452, "Blessd Be the Name of the Lord." Brother Keene prayed. The C.P.C. Quartet sang "Rock of Ages, Hide Thou Me," and "How Firm a Foundation."

Brother Hawkins brought a devotional message on "Progress & Pattern," using for a text, Numbers 13:30, "Let us go up at once and possess it for we are well able to overcome it."

The Secretary called the Conference roll. It was moved and seconded to receive Brother and Sister Powell, Brother Tucker, and Brother Eversole into the conference. Motion Carried.

The Conference Bar was set to include the first five seats on the Speaker's left and the platform. The time of the sittings were set at 9:00 to 11:30 A.M., and 1:30 P.M. to finish.

It was announced that the time from 11:00 to 11:30 would be given to the Ambassador's Quartet to tell about Central Pilgrim College.

It was moved and seconded to seat Sister Eversole as a delegate from the Lyford Church. Carried.

The Former District Superintendent's Report was read. The chair entertained a motion to receive the same. Motion carried.

Rev. Powell moved to instruct the secretary to send greetings from this conference to Brother and Sister Burcham via telegram today, and a letter later. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was read and accepted.

The Statistician's report was read and accepted.

Brother Ferlet the Sunday School Promotional Secretary, reported, and then presented Progress Awards, to San Antonio with a 61.3% gain, and to San Antonio with a numerical gain of 19. Ribbons were presented to the following churches: Lyford, 5% gain; Hillsboro, 12.5% gain; Dalhart 21.4% gain; and San Antonio 61.3% gain. The report was accepted.

The Executive Youth Director, Rev. Paul Scheuermeier, reported some interesting activity in the Dallas-Fort Worth-Hillsboro area. His report was duly accepted.

The Educational and Examining Board reported, and the report was approved.

The Resolutions Committee reported, and the first resolution was passed. It was moved and seconded to send a letter of appreciation to the C. M. Porter Construction Company and to the First Nazarene Church of Fort Worth for their kindness to this conference. Carried.

The Quartet presented the Central Pilgrim College program.

The conference adjourned by expiration of time.

### THIRD SITTING

At 1:30 P.M. the afternoon session began with the delegates singing "A Charge to Keep." Brother Eversole led in prayer. The minutes of the morning session were read and approved.

The Ambassador's Quartet sang, "I Know the Lord."

The San Antonio Church was received into the Conference, fully organized.

The Ways and Means Committee report was read and approved.

The Chairman announced that the following appointments had been made by the General Board of the Pilgrim Holiness Church:

District Superintendent Rev. R. T. Powell

District Secretary, Rev. S. A. Thomas

District Treasurer, Mr. Thomas Dillingham

The election of officials was declared the order of the day. Brothers Keene and Eversole were appointed tellers.

Ballots were cast for the vacancy on the Educational and Examining Board, after the secretary announced that the Council had nominated Scheuermeier, Ferlet, and Thomas. Rev. Thomas was chosen to serve on that Board.

Rev. Rufus Rumble, of Huntington, Indiana, was introduced to the Conference, and granted an honorary seat in the Conference Bar.

The Committee on Memoirs reported, and the chairman called for the conference to stand in silent prayer in memory of this departed saint, and then Brother Hawkins led in prayer.

The new District Superintendent read the Committee appointments.

The Miscellaneous resolutions were read and passed.

The conference adjourned. Brother W. A. Reed dismissed the conference with prayer.

## REPORT OF THE EDUCATIONAL AND EXAMINING BOARD

We recommend that Larry B. Jarvis and William Whybrew be granted Fourth Year Minister's License. We recommend that Elmer W. Molle and Frances Purselley be granted First Year's Minister's License.

We recommend that the standing of Lola Mae Coates be ratified by the District Council at a later date.

We recommend that Licensed Deaconess credentials be issued to Mrs. Allen Thomas and Miss Paula Hernandez.

We recommend that the following be dropped because they have transferred to another District: Roy E. Nible and Lily Penny.

## REPORT OF THE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

1. A. Be it resolved that the District Budget be 15% of all local monies (unspecified).

B. Be it resolved that the District Superintendent shall meet with each pastor and board setting up a program to raise the United Stewardship Fund.

C. Be it resolved that each church be urged to participate in the of \$8.00 per member, plus \$2.00 per member Contingent Fund. .... Self-denial offering for World Missions, the Easter offering for the Church Extension Department, the Sunday School Rally Day offering, and other such special projects.

2. We recommend that the District pay \$50.00 per month on the salary of the District Superintendent.

3. We recommend that the phone and utility bills of the District Superintendent be paid by the District.

4. We recommend that the District pay any mailing or traveling expenses authorized by the District Superintendent.

## REPORT OF THE RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE

1. We recommend that the annual business of the church be closed on April 30th. We also recommend that the District Treasurer's books be closed on May 10th, and that each church send all District funds to the District Treasurer before May 10th.

2. Be it resolved that the Annual Conference be held June 3-4, 1964, the place to be set by the District Council.

3. We recommend that a quarterly bulletin be compiled by the District Superintendent, and sent to each church at the beginning of each quarter. Be it further resolved that the amounts of budget paid by each church in that quarter be published in said bulletin.

4. We recommend that a Worker's Convention be held during the year, the time and place to be agreed upon by the District Superintendent, the General Secretary of Church Extension, and the District Council.

5. We recommend that each church set aside one service each month as

a time for bringing donations to the Pastor, announced by a deacon or deaconess of the local church as provided for by the manual, page 28, section 50.

6. We recommend that the location of the churches and parsonages appear in the minutes. We further recommend that where the parsonages are equipped with telephones, the name of the pastor and the Pilgrim Holiness Church be listed in the directory, and also that the number appear in the minutes.

7. Be it resolved that the churches of the Texas District be zoned as follows: Zone 1, Corpus Christi, Houston, Lyford, Raymondville and San Antonio; Zone 2, Dallas, Fort Worth, and Hillsboro; Zone 3, Borger and Dalhart.

8. Be it resolved that no church or church group in this District shall build or cause to be built any structure or improvement exceeding a cost of \$500.00 without authorization from the District Superintendent and General Secretary of Church Extension.

9. We recommend that each pastor and his wife be enrolled in the Ministerial Benefit Association, with the local church assuming all financial obligations.

### SUNDAY SCHOOL

1. We recommend that there be a Sunday School Promotional Secretary. We further recommend that each pastor send him a report on Monday following the last Sunday of each month, including average Sunday School attendance, church attendance, total calls and contacts made by the church and pastor, and other interesting news from his church, which the promotional secretary shall include in a monthly bulletin to be issued to each of the churches.

### CONFERENCE

1. We recommend that the pastor see that the yearly reports be in the hands of the statistician by May 10th.

2. We recommend that each pastor report in full to the General Secretary of Church Extension and District Superintendent on blanks provided by the General Secretary.

3. We recommend that each pastor shall be granted a two weeks vacation with pay.

4. We recommend that no pastor shall call an evangelist outside our church without the approval of the District Superintendent.

5. We recommend that immediately following the conference the District Treasurer shall mail to each pastor an itemized notice of the financial responsibilities of his church to the District for the year, giving the address of the District Treasurer.

### MISCELLANEOUS

1. Whereas Almighty God has given us another year of progress on our District, and has permitted us to enjoy another conference, therefore be it

resolved that we express our appreciation to God by standing.

2. Whereas our General Secretary of Church Extension, Dr. R. C. Hawkins, has given unstintingly of his time and efforts to make this conference a success: therefore be it resolved that we should show our appreciation by standing and saying, "God Bless You."

3. We recommend that our secretary be authorized to write a word of appreciation to our retiring District Superintendent and his wife, expressing our hopes for her complete recovery.

4. Our efficient Secretary, Rev. Allen Thomas, has served faithfully this conference year: therefore it resolved that we express our sincere appreciation by a rising vote of thanks.

5. Be it resolved that this conference show its deep appreciation to the efficient District Treasurer, Rev. Larry Jarvis, who has served faithfully this year, by sending a letter of appreciation.

6. Be it resolved that we show our appreciation of our Sunday School Secretary, Rev. Anatole Feret, by according him a rising vote of thanks.

7. We recommend that a rising vote of thanks be given for the cooks and all who assisted them during this conference.

8. Be it resolved that the local church be accorded our appreciation for the entertainment enjoyed by this conference, for their untiring efforts to properly house us, and that the District Treasurer be authorized to pay the local church such financial help as needed to defray the cost.

9. We recommend that the secretary write to the building contractor, C. M. Porter Construction Co., expressing our appreciation for all considerations rendered in the construction of the Fort Worth church, and for the flowers sent for the conference.

10. We recommend that the secretary write to the pastor of the First Church of the Nazarene of Fort Worth, expressing our appreciation for the use of their fellowship hall and facilities to entertain our District Conference.
