STANDING RULES

1 Assembly Year

The Assembly year shall close June 30 and complete reports must be in the hands of the District Secretary by July 20th following. All reports must be reviewed by the local board and the church before being forwarded to the District Secretary. All reports received after July 20th shall be omitted from the yearly report.

2 Funds

Each church shall raise for General Budget the equivalent of \$.50 per member per year for General Administrative Expense, \$.60 for General Home Missions, plus \$1.90 per member for Foreign Missions. They shall also raise for District Budget the equivalent of \$1.65 per member.

3 Bible School Debt Fund

Each church shall raise for the Bible School Debt Fund the equivalent of \$3.00 per member per year, plus \$12.00 per year for all licensed and ordained ministers. All monies raised for the Bible School Debt Fund plus other Bible School offerings shall be sent to the Bible School Treasurer, Rev. H. T. Mills, 1020 South Washington Street, Owosso, Michigan.

4 Ministerial Tithes

One half of all ministerial tithes shall be turned to the support of the District Superintendent.

5 District and General Funds

All monies raised in the local church for district and general funds shall be sent to the District Treasurer, who shall forward general funds to the General Treasurer.

6 District Officials Salaries

The District Superintendent's salary is fixed at a minimum of \$1,800.00 plus 2 cents per mile for traveling expenses. District Treasurer \$50.00 per year and District Secretary \$50.00 per year.

7 Pastor's Camp Meeting Offering

Inasmuch as our pastors are expected to support and attend the annual camp meeting, each church shall provide the regular pastor's offering for the two Sundays of the camp, and that the pastors be privileged to attend the entire camp meeting.

8 Examining Board

The District Superintendent shall be chairman of the Examining Board by virtue of his office.

9 Camp Meeting Expense

Churches are to be rated according to their financial strength and part of the Camp Meeting expense is to be raised among the churches of the district. All money raised for this purpose shall be in the hands of the District Treasurer not later than thirty days prior to camp meeting.

JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS

FIRST SITTING

The first sitting of the Fortieth Annual Assembly of the Michigan District of the Pilgrim Holiness Church was opened at 9:00 A. M., August 12th, 1940. Congregational singing was led by Rev. Russell Mohl with Rev. Gaylord Skinner at the piano.

Prayer was offered by Rev. B. O. Shattuck.

Rev. M. L. Goodman, district secretary, read a letter of greeting from the General Superintendent, Rev. W. L. Surbrook.

It was moved and seconded that the letter be included in the minutes. The motion was carried.

The Scripture lesson, Ephesians 2, was read by Rev. Calvin Hendricks.

In accordance with the request made by the General Superintendent, Rev. J. R. Thompson, district superintendent, took the chair to preside over this Assembly. He gave a short message asking the help of the Lord and the co-operation of this Assembly to make this meeting one in which the Spirit of Holiness might prevail, referring to Hebrews 12:14 and Hebrews 2:11.

Roll was called by the Secretary, Rev. M. L. Goodman.

Moved and seconded that Mrs. Don Price be seated as a delegate from Detroit First Church. The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that Mrs. Herbert Eastman be seated as a delegate from Jolly Corners Church at Lansing.

The motion was carried.

A telegram of greeting was read from Rev. A. S. Joppie.

Moved and seconded that the first eight seats in the three center sections of the tabernacle be fixed as the Assembly bar.

The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that Rev. B. E. Manker assist the Secretary during this Assembly.

The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that three new churches, namely: Kalamazoo, Brightmoor, Dearborn, be accepted into the District.

The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that the time for sittings be fixed at 9:00 to 12:00, 2:00 to 5:00 and 7:00 to 9:00. The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that the Chair appoint tellers.

The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that Rev. Ed. Boone be invited within the Assembly bar with full privileges of the floor.

The motion was carried.

The Chair appointed the following tellers: Rev. G. E. Stace, Rev. Edgar J. Haskins, Rev. Joe Meulman, Rev. Emil Shetler, Rev. G. V. Skinner, Rev. L. C. Philo, Rev. L. N. Nelson.

Moved and seconded that Rev. Harold Rickner be invited within the bar with privileges of the floor. The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that Rev. Milton Schweitzer be invited within the bar and given privileges of the floor. The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that inasmuch as Rev. T. H. Myers is pastoring our church at Dearborn, that he be invited within the bar with privileges of the floor. The motion was carried.

Brother Paul DeGrand Champ was introduced to the Assembly.

The Auditing Committee reported that they had audited the books of the Treasurers of the Bible Holiness Seminary, the Michigan District, and the Michigan District Young People's Organization and found them to be correct.

Moved and seconded that the report of the Auditing Committee be accepted. The motion was carried.

It was moved and seconded that the Treasurer of Bible Holiness Seminary close his books as of July 31st instead of June 30th as heretofore. The motion was carried.

The Examining Board submitted the following recommendations:

TO THE FORTIETH ANNUAL ASSEMBLY OF THE PILGRIM HOLINESS CHURCH OF THE MICHIGAN DISTRICT:

Greetings:—Another year has come and gone and we are still spared as monuments of God's grace and mercy. As a district we have been the thankful recipients of His unmerited favor and blessings. Great has been the Lord's blessing on the ministry and laity of the district. The Holy Spirit has aided us in a gracious and marked way, and we are assured that He is stamping His divine approval on the work of the Pilgrim Holiness Church of this district.

It has been a genuine delight and pleasure to have had the privilege of serving to the best of my humble ability as superintendent of the district and servant of the Lord during the past year. Rev. M. L. Goodman was elected Secretary.

Rev. A. F. Osborn was elected Treasurer.

Rev. B. O. Shattuck, Rev. A. C. Doehring and Rev. W. H. Joppie were elected advisory members of the District Council.

Rev. B. O. Shattuck was elected to serve on the Board of Examiners for term 1940 to 1945.

It was moved and supported that the rules be suspended and the Secretary be instructed to cast the ballot for the election of Rev. H. T. Mills, Rev. George Lounds and Rev. C. E. Cliff to the office of District Trustees for the coming year. The motion was carried.

Rev. E. G. Ritenburg was elected Trustee for Bible Holiness Seminary to fill vacancy caused by the resignation of Rev. S. I. Emery.

Brother and Sister Truman Miller were introduced to the Assembly and invited within the Assembly bar.

Rev. Brush, pastor of the Nazarene church of Durand was introduced to the Assembly and invited within the Assembly bar.

The Assembly stood adjourned by expiration of time.

THIRD SITTING

The third sitting of the Michigan Annual Assembly of the Pilgrim Holiness Church was opened at 7:30, August 12th, 1940, with congregational singing led by Rev. Russell Mohl. This being an ordination service, the songs chosen were "A Charge to Keep I Have" and "Rock of Ages."

The minutes of the third sitting were read and corrected.

Moved and seconded that the minutes of the third sitting of this Assembly be adopted. The motion was carried.

The Examining Board recommended that Virgil Appleton be given a license with a two year standing and that Walter Gaylord be given a license with a one year standing.

Moved and seconded that the recommendation of the Examining Board be adopted. The motion was carried.

The Resolutions Committee recommended that the following reso-

lution be adopted:

Be it resolved that the District Superintendent or the Assistant District Superintendent conduct all annual meetings in the District.

Moved and seconded that the resolution be adopted.

The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that the following resolution be made a standing rule:

"Be it resolved that the churches be rated according to their financial strength and part of the camp meeting expense be raised among the churches of the district. All money raised for this purpose shall be in the hands of the District Treasurer not later than thirty days prior to camp meeting.

"Be it further resolved that the apportionment be left to the District Council."

Moved and seconded that the Chair appoint the Committee for the next year. The motion was carried.

The Chair announced the appointment of his Committees.

Moved and seconded that the District Superintendent be chairman of the Examining Board and that this be made a standing rule.

Moved and seconded that the District Council be authorized to take care of any unfinished business of this Assembly, which is to include the approval of the minutes of this fourth sitting and the issuance of ordination certificates to those who in previous years have failed to receive them. The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that the Assembly give a rising vote of thanks to Sister J. E. Strong for the presentation to the District of the Geo. B. Kulp Memorial Tabernacle. The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that the District Superintendent, Rev. J. R. Thompson, be given a rising vote of thanks for the able way in which he has presided at this Assembly. The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that a rising vote of thanks be given Rev. and Mrs. H. T. Mills and Rev. E. C. Swanson for hospitality given at this camp meeting; also that thanks be given other workers.

The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that a rising vote of thanks be given Rev. M. L. Goodman and Rev. A. F. Osborn for their faithful services throughout the year. The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that the District purchase an adding machine.

The motion was carried.

Brother James Fields was introduced to the Assembly.

Moved and seconded that a fan be purchased for the kitchen of Bible Holiness Seminary. The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that the electric wiring system serving this tabernacle be improved by the placing of poles for wiring.

The motion was carried.

Moved and seconded that our Secretary be instructed to write to our United States Senators registering the opposition of this Assembly to the proposed conscription legislation.

The motion was carried.

The meeting was adjourned.

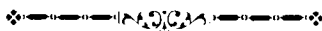
