### JOURNAL OF PROCEEDINGS

#### FIRST SITTING

Owosso, Mich., August 15, 1949 The first sitting of the 49th Annual Conference of the Michigan District of the Pilgrim Holiness Church convened at 9:00 A. M. Aug. 15 at Seminary Park Tabernacle, Owosso, Michigan.

The Conference was called to order by Rev. R. C. Hawkins, District Superintendent. Rev. Paul Trissel led the congregation in the singing of "At the Cross." Mrs. Trissel was at the piano. Rev. L. R. Neff, Assistant Superintendent, offered the opening prayer of the Conference.

Rev. Hawkins introduced Rev. S. M. Stikeleather, Gen. Sec. of the Pilgrim Holiness Church, as the Presiding Officer of the Conference. He brought timely greetings. He then read I Cor. 13 and spoke of the necessity of being longsuffering and kind.

The chair then requested that Rev. H. T. Mills be seated on the platform being a member of the General Board of the church.

The chairman read a telegram from the Rev. L. W. Sturk, General Superintendent, stating his regrets in not being able to attend this Conference, but asking God's blessing and leadings in all things.

The Secretary called the roll. The Examining and Educational Board recommended the following Ministers and Deaconess to the Conference: Ordained ministers, Mrs. Thelma D. Brown, Rev. G. E. Pettersen, Rev. K. W. Phipps: Licensed Minister, Mrs. Margaret Kovacic Snyder: Ordained Deaconess, Mrs. G. E. Pettersen. It was carried that these be received into our District and to our fellowship.

The Examining and Educational Board further reported, which report was accepted.

The District Superintendent read his report which was accepted.

It was moved and carried that the new churches namely, Flint Pasadena, Kingston, The Heights and Wayne, be presented with their pastors and delegates. These were accepted into the District.

Rev. Hawkins asked the Conference to accept Rev. Mrs. Lydia Briggs, an ordained minister of the Free Methodist Church. After a testimony it was carried that she be accepted into the District.

District Statistician, H. C. Rickner, read his report and it was accepted.

The following visitors were introduced: Rev. Bray from Ontario, Can., Rev. Bert Crites of Muskegon, and Rev. Pittman of the United Missionary Church. After a word of testimony from each they were granted a seat within the Conference bar. It was requested that Rev. Crites sing during the Devotional period of the afternoon sitting.

The Auditing Committee found that the books of the Treasurer of Bible Holiness Seminary, The District Treasurer, District Young People's Society, District S. S. Sec., District Missionary Society and the Editor of the Michigan Pilgrim to be correct.

Rev. G. V. Skinner, Sec. of the Resolution committee read nine resolutions of this committee.

A motion prevailed to adjourn.

#### SECOND SITTING

The Second Sitting convened at 1:30 P. M. Monday, Aug. 15, 1949. Rev. C. V. Holstein led in the singing of "Beulah Land." Mrs. G. V. Skinner was at the piano.

Rev. H. T. Mills read a scripture lesson, Psalm 37. He used the 37th verse as a basis for his remarks, "Mark the Perfect Man." Rev. J. R. Thompson, former District Superintendent led in prayer, Rev. Stike-

leather requested Rev. Surbrook, former General Superintendent to sit on the platform.

The Minutes of the previous sitting were read and approved.

Resolutions No. 6 and No. 7 were carried.

Resolution No. 3 was again read by Committee Secretary. After a lengthy discussion and a season of prayer a vote was taken by ballot.

The motion prevailed that we extend the time until the ballots were counted. The Resolution was passed.

Inasmuch as one candidate could not be here for the Ordination service tonight, it was moved and carried that a special Ordination Service be held on Tuesday night, providing he is present at that time.

Rev. G. V. Skinner dismissed with prayer.

#### THIRD SITTING

The third sitting of the Conference convened at 7:00 P. M. August 15. With Rev. Skinner at the piano, Rev. Holstein led in the singing of "Honey in the Rock" followed by two choruses.

Rev. Stace read a scripture lesson Acts 2:41-47, after which he led in prayer.

Rev. and Mrs. Patrick, pastor of the Methodist Church of Ashley, Mich. were introduced to the conference and granted an honorary seat within the Conference bar.

Resolutions Nos. 8 and 10 were read and passed. It was moved and carried that Resolution No. 9 be referred to the committee for redrafting. Resolution No. 11 was passed.

The motion prevailed that Eldon Nelson be granted a second year license.

The Ways and Means Committee reported.

Resolution No. 1 was passed.

It was moved and carried that we defer action on Resolution No. 2 until the next sitting.

The Next order of business was the Ordination Service.

Rev. Holstein led in the singing of "A Charge to Keep I Have." after which Rev. Hendrick prayed. The Congregation was led in the singing of "Rock of Ages,"

The following scriptures were read: II Tim. 4:1-8 by Rev. R. C. Hawkins; Titus 3:1-11 by Rev. W. L. Surbrook and Rev. G. E. Stace read I Tim. 1:1-11. Rev. Stikeleather addressed the candidates basing his remarks on II Tim. 4:2 and 2:15. He made the charge to the candidates exhorting them to preach the Word, study and manifest the proper Spir-'Bless Be the Tie" was sung and all extended to these brethren the it. ' right hand of fellowship.

Rev. Hawkins dismissed with prayer.

#### FOURTH SITTING

The fourth sitting of the Conference convened at 9:00 A. M. Aug. 16.

Rev. Wayne Brown led in the singing of "He Brought Me Out" and "At the Cross." Rev. Hendrick led in a gracious season of prayer.

Rev. Hawkins read an interesting letter from Miss Orpha Case, Missionary of the Pilgrim Industrial Institute, Mr. Frere, Cape Province, South Africa.

Moved and carried that the secretary send greetings to Miss Case from this Conference.

The Minutes of the previous sitting were read and approved.

According to previous action the Ways and Means Committee again presented Resolution No. 2 to the Conference. The Resolution was lost.

Mrs. Manker reported for the District Missionary Society. Her report was accepted.

The report of the Treasurer of the Michigan Pilgrim, Rev. L. R. Neff, was received and accepted.

The Secretary of the Committee on Memorials to the General Conference reported.

Memorial No. 1 regarding Bible School Funds was passed.

Memorial No. 2 regarding Dedication of children was received.

Memorial No. 3 "Editorial Corrections" was passed.

The report of the Memorial Committee, by Mrs. E. F. Ewers, was accepted after which the Doxology was sung.

It was moved and carried that the first order of business following the recess, be the election of officers.

Moved and carried that we have a ten minute recess.

Following the recess we sang, "We're Marching to Zion", after which Rev. Mills led in prayer.

A motion to defer election with its amendment was tabled.

Rev. Stikeleather called on Rev. A. S. Joppie to pray before we proceed with the election.

The District Superintendent appointed the following tellers; Norval Rickner, Laurel Silvers, Lewis Hyde, Wayne Brown, Russell Barkman and R. E. Richards.

The election of officers was as follows: District Superintendent, Rev. -R. C. Hawkins.

Adjourned by expiration of time. Rev. Mills dismissed with prayer.

#### FIFTH SITTING

Rev. Stikeleather called the fifth sitting of the Conference to order. Rev. J. L. Schell led in the singing of "He Took My Sins Away", and "Heavenly Sunlight." He then read the scripture lesson, John 10:1-9. At the request of the chair, Rev. Schell sang, "He Satisfies My Soul." Rev. B. E. Manker led in prayer.

The minutes of the previous sitting were read and approved.

Election of officers continued: The other District Superintendent elected was Rev. Calvin Hendrick; Assistant Superintendent in the North, E. C. Swanson; Assistant Superintendent in the South, L. R. Neff; District Treasurer, A. F. Osborn.

Recessed until 7:00 P. M.

#### SIXTH SITTING

The sixth sitting of the 1949 Conference convened at 7:00 o'clock, August 16. Rev. Stikeleather called the Conference to order. The order of business being the ordaining of Charles Manker, who could not be present for the regular Ordination Service.

Rev. Brown led in the singing of "A Charge to Keep." Rev. R. C. Hawkins led in prayer. Followed by singing "Rock of Ages." The chair requested that the candidate's parents, Rev. and Mrs. B. E. Manker, come forward and sit with their son.

At the request of the chair, Rev. Surbrook gave the charge basing his remarks on I Tim. 3:1-6. He exhorted to the necessity of being blameless spiritually, Doctrinally, Socially, Financially, Influencially. Members of the District Council extended a hand of fellowship as "Bless Be the Tie" was sung.

It was moved and carried that the eight names receiving the highest number of votes be the delegates, and that the next eight be the alternates. In case of a tie the District Council will declare the one for delegate and the other the first alternate.

Rev. Hawkins appointed the following tellers to count the lay Delegates vote and bring the report of the results to the Conference in the morning, Rev. Pettersen, Rev. Wilcox and Rev. Finney.

The Resolution Committee presented Resolution Nos. 11 and 12 which were passed.

Trustees for Bible Holiness Seminary elected were Rev. R. C. Hawkins, Rev. H. T. Mills, Rev. G. E. Stace.

By request Miss Ruth Alexander sang a special song.

Loren Swanson was elected District Trustee.

A love offering taken for Rev. and Mrs. Stikeleather amounted to \$73.45.

By common consent Rev. Stikeleather was granted his request to be excused from the Conference and Rev. Surbrook should take the chair.

After the singing of the Doxology Rev. Stikeleather dismissed with prayer.

#### **REPORT TO CONFERENCE - 1949**

To the forty-ninth annual conference of the Michigan District of the Pilgrim Holiness Church:

Greetings to you in the name of him who lifted us from the pit of despair and sin, to an honored place in the company of the redeemed. At the close of a glorious and fruitful camp-meeting, all of us have gratitude and praise springing heavenward from our hearts. With each passing year this annual gathering becomes more sacred to us. During this conference, we not only want to do business, but also we want to keep an attitude of heart and mind that will be conducive to times of blessing. Furthermore, of all times when we need the direction of the Spirit, we need it now. May none of us allow our prejudices or pre-conceived notions hinder or spoil the operation of the Holy Spirit in our midst.

May I take this opportunity to commend the ministry and membership of our Conference. Your fellowship is reflective of the real spirit of Christ, your sacrifices have made it possible for us to go beyond the normal, your prayers have solved impossible problems, and your devotion to Christ and the church stands out gloriously in a skeptical generation.

We live in an unspiritual age, when all that is in the world, is against Godliness and deep piety. However our church is recognized as a spiritual church. Let us not only strive to keep it so, but do all we can to advance in things spiritual. We must not tolerate in our midst the things that have brought on the downfall of others. Their gains have been consistent and large. The young people's department has shown a good gain again this year. Also, forty of our churches have shown a gain in membership. May God bless these churches and Pastors. Let us all strive to gain in every segment of our church next year.

The following material gains have been made this year:

Detroit First—G. E. Stace, Pastor; Practically completed construction of a forty by eighty church building.

Battle Creek--W. N. Miller, Pastor; Began construction of a church building that is fifty-eight by one hundred.

Monroe—Reverend J. A. Hiatt, Pastor; Began construction of a large new church building. These three churches are large, fire-proof structures that should more or less set the pattern for many of our churches.

Clio—Reverend W. L. Silvers, Pastor; Completed erection of a church building and converted original building into a parsonage.

Frankfort—Reverend J. L. Cliff; Completed a lovely new church building.

Flint Second—Reverend R. K. Ballard, Pastor; Began construction of a new parsonage.

Flint Pasadena Avenue—Reverend Russell Barkman, Pastor; Purchased an excellently located, corner lot for the purpose of erecting a church building.

Hope—Reverend A. W. Lacey, Pastor; Constructing a nice parsonage. Iron Mountain—F. L. Fairchild, Pastor; Re-modeled present building, into a nice auditorium as well as living quarters.

Newberry-Reverend Lloyd Walker, Pastor; Modernizing the parsonage.

Traverse Heights-Reverend C. B. Greenman, Pastor; Erecting a beautiful new parsonage.

Kingston—Reverend H. C. Rickner, Pastor; Constructing a Sunday School unit in church basement.

Wayne-Reverend C. G. Denniston, Pastor; Purchased a well-located church building.

In our church extension department we have launched a total of six new projects in practically every section of the state. It is hoped that

those who have not already done so, will soon become full-fledged Pilgrim Holiness churches. There have been four new churches organized this year as follows: Early last fall the people in the Baptist church at Kingston, voted unanimously to unite with the Pilgrim Holiness Church. They were subsequently organized with twenty-four charter members. The Rickner brothers have successfully labored in this field. Reverend C. G. Denniston has blasted out a new church in Wayne, Michigan, which has been organized with eight charter members. The District made a small loan to these people and it was re-paid within a matter of months. The church at Houghton Heights has developed to a place where it was organized with sixteen charter members. This great field presents a challenge to its Pastor, Reverend John Maes, who is successfully laboring there. Just a few weeks ago the Pasadena Avenue church in Flint was organized with eleven charter members. Reverend Russell Barkman has led the way here and is working long and hard to successfully meet this challenge. All of these churches are well located and composed of good, clean spiritual people that are a credit to our church. The Pastors and delegates are ready to respond to the call of the chair, to have these churches received into our Conference.

Many of our churches have had good revivals this year. Showers of blessings still fall on Pilgrims and good progress is being made. The church at Newberry is going forward on every line in an unprecedented way. Reverend Lloyd Walker is leading the way in an aggressive movement that promises much for the future of that church. Under the leadership of the Reverend W. D. Phillips, the church at Alma is making substantial progress. The same could be said of the church at North Branch, where Reverend A. F. Osborn labors effectually. Honorable mention could be made of most of our churches and Pastors for their courageous efforts in seeking the lost. May God richly bless you one and all.

This Conference should not only be a time to report our various successes, but also it should be a time to look squarely at our problems and pass legislation that will aid us to solve them, making it possible for us to go forward as we have never done before. With this in mind your attention is now being called to the fifteen point program that I presented to the Ministerial Convention. It is my earnest desire that this Conference will enact the legislation that is needed in order for us to better meet the challenge of our day.

#### CONFERENCE RESOLUTIONS

No. 1—We recommend that the trustees of each local church shall investigate the insurance coverage upon all local church property, and that the trustees recommend to the local church board an increase in their insurance where necessary.

No. 2—Be it resolved that on the two Sundays during camp meeting that there be a Sunday School session beginning at 9:30 and until 10:15 following the testimony meeting; and that said session be arranged and supervised by the Sunday School committee.

Be it further resolved that a credit card be given to all in attendance, and that each card be signed and returned by the pupil to their local church Sunday School secretary for the attendance record and reports to the Conference.

No. 3—Whereas our present conference comprises approximately seventy-two churches, and our state from North to South points covers such a large territory for travel, we therefore recommend that we shall have one conference, and one council, with two districts.

Each district shall have a full time district Superintendent with full authority in his respective district.

The boundary line of the two districts shall begin at Bay City and south on route 23 to route 46, and extend westward on route 46 to St. Louis, and from thence south on route 27 to St. Johns, and from thence westward on route 21 to Holland. All towns and cities located on this boundary line shall be included in the North District.

The following rules would apply:

- A. The conference would elect two men to serve as Superintendents of the two Districts. The district council would after this election appoint the men to their respective districts.
- B. The Assistant Superintendents shall be elected by the Conference and out of the District in which he is to serve.
- C. We recommend that the Conference Council consist of nine members as follows: Two District Superintendents; Two Assistant Superintendents; Conference Secretary; Conference Treasurer; Three advisory members, one elected at large, and one from each District.
- D. We recommend that the District Superintendents alternate in presiding at the council meetings unless otherwise required by emergencies.
- E. Whereas the new district of our conference will not be provided with living quarters for it's duly elected superintendent, we recommend that the District Council choose a suitable place and location.
- F. We recommend that the District Superintendents be members of the Camp Meeting Board by virtue of their office.
- G. Be it further resolved that all ministers give their full ministerial tithe into the District Superintendent's Fund.

No. 4—Be it resolved that the following be added to standing rule 14: "The conference shall supply the same for the District Parsonages."

No. 5-Be it resolved that the ministerial convention be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in February. Be it further resolved that this become a standing rule.

No. 6—Be it resolved that a committee be appointed by the District Superintendent to include the Conference Secretary and District Statistician, who shall meet with the pastors for the purpose of revising our present report blank. No. 7—Whereas we feel the need of a Camp Meeting Committee, be it resolved that the District Council nominate twelve men to the Conference, six of whom shall be elected to form a Camp Meeting Committee, who shall be amenable to the District Council. The duties of the Committee shall be:

A. Secure all manual workers for the Camp and Conference.

- B. Supervision of Camp grounds and buildings.
- C. Purchase of good and necessary equipment for Camp Meeting and Conference.
- D. Have charge of all Camp Meeting Advertising.

No. 8—Be it resolved that this conference authorize the District Council to enlarge the Tabernacle.

No. 9—Be it resolved that whenever there shall be elected another District Superintendent, that the Conference Council take steps to fill the pastorate left vacant by the recommending of the retiring Superintendent to that church as Pastor. The Conference Council may also recommend him to the field of evangelism.

No. 10—We recommend that the local Missionary Societies of the respective zones meet at least once a year for their promotional work. Such meeting shall be arranged for and organized by the chairman of the Zone Home Missionary Committee.

No. 11—Be it resolved that we suspend the rules and ask our Conference Council to appoint the camp meeting Board for this year.

No. 12—Whereas the conference appreciates the efficient and faithful services rendered by our General Secretary, Rev. S. M. Stikeleather in presiding over the conference. Be it resolved that a rising vote of thanks be given him and that a love offering be received and forwarded to Mrs. Stikeleather.

No. 13—Be it resolved that this conference consider the possibility of using the lumber already on the grounds for the purpose of enlarging the tabernacle. Be it further resolved that the ministers donate their time in labor when this addition is in building.

No. 14—Be it resolved that the time set for the Ordination service shall be the first night of the Conference at 8:30.

No. 15—Whereas the conference appreciates the good work done by the Camp Meeting Board in preparing the Campus and buildings, we recommend that a rising vote of thanks be given them.

No. 16—Whereas the conference appreciates the good work done in the dining room, kitchen, and ground workers, be it resolved that a rising vote of thanks be given them.

No. 17—Be it resolved that the second week of May shall be designated as the time for the churches of our Conference to vote on the recall of the pastor. We further recommend that each pastor shall answer within 15 days after receiving an official call.

No. 18—We recommend that Zone Home Missionary Committees be comprised of at least three Ministerial members, a chairman, who is to be the first man elected, two additional members and the Young People's Zone Chairman, to work with the District Superintendent in Home Extension work.

We further recommend that the respective Zones shall follow the same pattern as the District Young People's Societies Organization.

We further recommend that the pastors of each Zone organize at the same time the first Young People's Zone Rally is held in their respective Zone.

#### **RESOLUTIONS OF THE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE**

No. 1-Be it resolved that the Conference furnish the fuel for the District Parsonages. Be it further resolved that this be a Standing Rule.

No. 2-Be it resolved that Standing Rule No. 7 be made to read as follows: All ministerial tithes shall be turned to the support of the District Superintendents. Those ministers doing secular work shall turn one half of their tithe to the District Budget.

#### STANDING BULES

#### No. 1 CONFERENCE YEAR

The Conference year shall close June 30, and complete reports must be reviewed by the local boards and forwarded directly to the Conference Statistician, Rev. H. C. Rickner, Kingston, Michigan by July 15. All reports received after July 15 shall be omitted from the yearly report.

#### No. 2 GENERAL BUDGET

Each church shall raise for the general budget the equivalent of \$4.00 per member. 12.

#### **No. 3 CONFERENCE BUDGET**

The churches shall also raise for the Conference Budget the equivalent of \$4.50 per member, divided as follows: Home Missions 84 percent; District Expense 12 percent; General Conference, 4 percent. Pol above -

#### No. 4 BIBLE SCHOOL FUND

Each church shall raise for the Bible School Fund the equivalent of \$2.00 per member per year, pastor included at the same rate. All money raised for the Bible School Fund, plus other Bible School offerings shall be sent to the Treasurer of Bible Holiness Seminary, 1020 S. Washington St., Owosso, Michigan.

#### No. 5 MINISTERIAL RELIEF FUND

Each church shall provide the equivalent of \$1 00 per member, per  $P_{a,c}$  year: also each licensed or ordained minister and each licensed or ordained deaconess shall pay \$2.00 per year into the Ministerial Relief Fund.

#### No. 6 DISTRICT AND GENERAL FUND

All moneys raised in the local church for district and general work shall be sent to the Conference Treasurer, who shall forward general funds to the General Treasurer.

#### No. 7 MINISTERIAL TITHES

All ministerial tithes shall be turned to the support of the District Superintendents. Also ministers doing secular work shall turn one half of their tithe to the Conference Budget.

#### No. 8 PASTORS AT CAMP MEETING

Inasmuch as our pastors are expected to support and attend the Annual Camp Meeting, each church shall provide the equivalent of the pastors offering or salary for the two Sundays of the camp and the pastor shall be privileged to attend the entire Camp Meeting.

#### No. 9 EXAMINING AND EDUCATIONAL BOARD

The District Superintendent shall be chairman of the Examining and Educational Board by virtue of his office.

#### No. 10 CAMP MEETING EXPENSE

Churches are to be rated according to their financial strength and part of the Camp Meeting expense shall be raised among the churches of the District. The District Council shall prorate the expense among the churches. Recognized ministers of the Pilgrim Holiness Church, their wives and children sixteen years old and under shall be entertained free of charge for camp and Conference.

#### No. 11 RESOLUTIONS

No resolution shall be presented to this conference until it has been type-written and signed.

#### No. 12 CONFERENCE BAR

The first ten seats in the three middle sections of the tabernacle and the platform are fixed as the conference bar.

#### No. 13 SALARIES

The District Superintendent's salary is fixed at a minimum of \$3500.00 per year, plus 5 cents a mile for traveling expenses. The Conference Treasurer shall receive \$250.00 per year and the Conference Secretary shall receive \$150.00 per year.

#### No. 14 STOVES FOR PARSONAGES

The local church shall provide good modern heating and cooking facilities for the parsonage, the type to be suitable to the locality where the parsonage is situated. The Conference shall supply the same for the District parsonages.

#### No. 15 CREDENTIALS

The District Superintendent shall have read Sections 99, 100 and 101 of the Manual instructing all district licentiates that hereafter they shall appear before the District Examining board at Conference time before their credentials shall be granted.

#### No. 16 CAMP MEETING FUNDS

The Conference Treasurer shall submit an itemized report of camp meeting funds as recorded in the 1946 Conference Journal, page 18. This report to appear in the Minutes.

#### No. 17 APPOINTMENT OF COMMITTEES

The District Superintendent shall appoint all committees. The Standing Committees are to be appointed to include new men where possible and to avoid the duplication of men on several committees.

#### No. 18 BUILDING COMMITTEE

The Conference Council shall appoint a Conference Building Committee, composed of two ministers and one layman, who have experience in the work of acoustics, architecture and construction. This committee shall council and advise the board of local congregations concerning the construction and disposition of property and the selection of building sites.

#### No. 19 BURIAL BENEFIT

All actively engaged pastors, evangelists and ministers of the Conference shall be enrolled in the Ministerial Benefit Association as well as their wives. Cost of membership and calls shall be paid from the Treasuries of the department that employs them. Complete resolution appears in Standing Rule No. 20 of the 1947 Minutes.

#### No. 20 VACATIONS

It is recommended that our churches grant their ministers a twoweeks vacation with pay.

#### No. 21 MISSIONARY SOCIETY REPORTS

Be it resolved that a yearly report of each missionary society be printed in the Conference minutes.

#### No. 22 DISTRICT OFFICERS

In electing District officers, all shall be elected by open ballot except those nominated by the Conference Council as provided by the Manual.

#### No. 23 DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT VACATION

Our District Superintendent shall be given a two-weeks vacation with pay.

#### No. 24 ELECTIONS

There shall be no elimination of the names of candidates before an election.

#### No. 25 MINISTERIAL CONVENTION

Be it resolved that the Ministerial Convention be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in February.

#### No. 26 DISTRICT PARSONAGES FUEL

Be it resolved that the Conference furnish the fuel for the District Parsonages.

#### AUDITING COMMITTEE REPORT

The Auditing Committee found that the books of the Treasurer of Bible Holiness Seminary, The Conference Treasurer, Conference Young People's Society, S. S. Sec., Conference Missionary Society and the Books of the Editor of the Michigan Pilgrim to be correct.
