## Minutes of the Twenty-Third Annual Conference of the Oklahoma and Texas District

First sitting of the Conference convened at Hopeton, Okla., July 25, 1949, at 9:00 a. m. First Assistant General Superintendent, Rev. William Neff, presiding.

After a good song service and prayer by J. F. Wilson; Rev. Paul C. Nering addressed the Conference using Col. 1:1-18.

The District Secretary gave the roll call.

Motion prevailed that the first four of seats on the north and south and the first five rows in the center, constitute the Conference bar.

The reception Committee introduced Rev. and Mrs. L. C. Hiles, Rev. and Mrs. J. V. Hickman, Rev. and Mrs. Wm. H. Pope, Rev. Gus Turbyfill, Bro. Davis, Rev. and Mrs. Downing, Rev. Heckart and Rev. Maxie Walton, to the Conference.

Rev. D. R. Close gave an oral report of the new work in Dallas, Texas. A motion prevailed we receive the church into the Conference.

The report of Rev. D. R. Close, District Superintendent was given and received.

Motion prevailed the report of the Statistical committee be received and posted.

The recommendations of the Ways and Means Committees was given and accepted as printed in the Minutes.

The report of the District Treasurer was given and accepted as printed in the Minutes.

Motion prevailed Conference adjourn until the call of the Chair.

Conference reconvened at 1:30 p. m. Rev. Walton led in singing and prayer.

Rev. Wm. Neff addressed the Conference from the text, I Cor. 3:8-9. Using as a subject: The Kind Of Work We Are Doing.

The report of the Resolutions Committee was read and accepted as printed in the Minutes.

The report of the Examining Board was read and accepted.

An oral report was given by the pastors of the District, as to the work on their respective fields.

Motion prevailed conference adjourn 10 minutes, after which the election of officers be the order of the day.

Conference reconvened, and after prayer, the election of officers was the order of the day.

Rev. D. R. Close was re-elected as District Superintendent.

Rev. Paul C. Nering as Assistant District Superintendent.

Rev. J. F. Wilson as District Secretary.

Rev. E. G. Gafford as District Treasurer.

Rev. L. C. Hiles, W. P. Haltom, and M. G. Nelson as Advisory Members of the council.

Rev. Wm. Pope and Rev. J. V. Hickman were elected as Ministerial Delegates to the General Conference. Walter Quinn as Lay Delegate to the General Conference.

W. P. Haltom, was elected to the Bible School Board.

Motion prevailed the District Council be given power to fill any vacancy in the General Conference Delegation.

J. F. Wilson was elected to the Educational Board.

D. R. Close was elected to the Examining Board.

Memorials to the General Conference were read and accepted as printed in the Minutes.

Motion prevailed we print only ministers names in the memoirs in the District Minutes.

Motion prevailed the Conference adjourned.

## Recommendations of the Ways and Means Committee

1. We recommend that each church be budgeted as follows:

\* These two churches were not given a camp budget because of the camp being held there, they give during camp.

2. We recommend that the District Superintendent be paid four (4) cents per mile travel expense.

3. We recommend that all ministerial tithe be paid to the District Treasurer monthly, this money to be placed in the District Fund.

4. We recommend that each church raise a minimum equivalent to a penny per day for each assessable member for the Bible School. Said funds to be raised monthly, by the method preferred by the church, and forwarded to the District Treasurer so as to give the school a regular monthly income throughout the year.

5. We recommend that the registration fee for the camp be set at \$2.50 for adults who stay the full time, \$1.25 for those who come on or after the last Thursday. Children 5 to 12 one-half adult fee. We further recommend a fee of 50 cents be charged for the cots used the full camp, and 25 cents after the last Thursday.

6. We recommend the District Treasurer be paid a salary of \$50.

7. We recommend the District Secretary be paid a salary of \$30.

8. We recommend that the district postage, stationery, telegrams, and telephone calls be paid out of the district budget.

9. We recommend that all district and general funds be forwarded to the District Treasurer the first of each month.

10. We recommend that all district checks from the bank be kept on file, and turned over with the Treasurer's books.

11. We recommend that the District Superintendent be paid a salary of \$25 a week.

12. We recommend that the District Home Missionary offering, which is taken the last Sunday of camp, be applied in the interest of District Home Missions, and the distribution of all Home Missionary money shall be left to the District Council.

13. We recommend we have 200 copies of the 1949 Minutes printed, and that we sell them at 25 cents per copy.

14. We recommend that each minister and deaconess, both licensed and ordained, be assessed a conference fee of \$2.00, the same to be paid before the end of the first quarter.

15. We recommend that all children attending camp be accompanied by a parent or guardian, and that they be subject to all camp rules.

## Recommendations of the Resolutions Committee

### STANDING RESOLUTIONS

1. We recommend that the fiscal year close June 30th.
2. Inasmuch as the District Treasurer has so much work to do at the close of the year, be it resolved that all district and general monies be sent to the District Treasurer not later than July 10th.
3. Be it resolved that all delegates exceed the age of eighteen years.
4. Be it resolved that the Council make arrangements for a quarterly bulletin of district interest to be sent to each church.
5. Whereas it is so expensive to buy new tents and we must conserve the one we have, be it resolved that each time the tent is used for established churches the sum of \$5.00 be sent to the district treasurer, and that \$15.00 be paid for the use during District Camp; also that each Sunday School with an attendance of under 50 pay 10c per week and the schools with an attendance over 50 pay 20c per week into the tent fund.
6. In order that we may conserve the Lord's money and give our churches the advantage of evangelistic meetings, be it resolved that we as pastors and churches consult our Superintendent in slating Evangelists and, if it is possible and practical, that they be slated for two or more consecutive meetings which would keep down traveling expense.
7. Inasmuch as there is a great blessing derived from a ministerial and Christian workers convention, be it resolved that during the year we have a three-day convention in the district to be divided between the Ministerial and Sunday School interests. The council shall be the committee to set the time and prepare the program.
8. We recommend that the District Superintendent appoint all committees for the next year during the present conference sitting.
9. Be it resolved that our camp begin the third Friday in July.
10. Be it resolved that each minister come a day earlier and stay throughout the camp and a day after camp unless excused by the District Council. If it is impossible to come, unless excused, be it resolved that he send the sum of \$5.00 to help on camp meeting expense or to hire labor in erecting and dismantling the camp equipment whichever the council deems needful.
11. Be it resolved that each pastor have the privilege of conducting two revivals off charge during the year, or his choice of a two weeks vacation with pay and one meeting leaving the pastor responsible for supply; providing that the charge be supplied satisfactorily with the local church board.
12. Resolved that the camp have children and young people services, the District Council to secure a leader for each and said meetings to be announced on the camp meeting bills.
13. Resolved that the District Council set the date for the District Conference.
14. Resolved that each active minister be released for two Sundays during the camp and conference and that they receive regular salary or offering, providing they attend Camp and Conference.
15. Resolved that the first prayer meeting night in each month shall be donation night for the pastors of the district. The announcement shall be made the Sunday previous by someone appointed by the local church board.
16. Be it resolved that the pastors be required to see that all reports are mailed to the District Superintendent by the 15th of the month following the close of the quarter, and that the annual reports be mailed to the chairman of the Statistical Committee by July 15th.
17. Be it resolved that the District remain divided into zones as follows: Zone 1, Hopeton, Pleasant View and Fairview; Zone 2, Pond Creek, Blackwell, Newkirk, and Enid; Zone 3, Henryetta, Oklahoma City, and Bethany; Zone 4, Devine, Hillsboro, and Dallas.
18. Be it further resolved, that the pastors of each zone constitute the committee to prepare the program for the rallies in their respective zones.
19. We further recommend that when practical and possible one rally be conducted in each zone during the year, and that all rallies shall be under the supervision of the District Superintendent.

20. Resolved that we have a workers meeting in the 1950 camp meeting beginning at 9:15 a. m. to 10:15.

#### NEW RESOLUTIONS

1. Whereas the Pilgrim Holiness Church has assumed a responsibility in supporting and caring for the missionaries going out under our church and whereas our missionary work is very extensive. And whereas the National Holiness Association is sending their representatives to the Association meetings for the purpose of advancing their interest in missions; be it resolved that our ministers go no farther in the Association than that of fellowship and that they comply with the manual page 44 pra. 14 relative to all representatives. (Our pastors should not grant the use of their churches to those claiming to be missionaries or raising money for religious work, unless such persons have proper endorsement of the District Council.)

2. We recommend the following goals for this next year. 20% increase in Sunday School Attendance; 15% increase in membership; 100% up on budgets each quarter. We recommend that a report be gotten out at the end of each quarter and sent to each church the same being placed on the bulletin board showing each church's standing for the quarter.

3. Whereas there is a danger of valuable papers becoming lost in our local churches, we recommend that the District rent a safety deposit box and all churches send their abstracts, deeds, etc. to the District Superintendent for safe keeping in said box. This box shall be rented near the District Superintendent's residence.

4. Resolved that each pastor give a three minute report in district conference concerning his church's progress during the year covering spiritual, financial, and numerical gains.

5. Be it resolved that the District Superintendent be granted two weeks vacation with pay.

#### SPECIAL RESOLUTIONS

1. Be it resolved that we, the District Conference, express our appreciation to our District Superintendent, Rev. D. R. Close for his labors of love among us the past year by a rising vote of thanks.

2. Be it resolved that we, the District Conference, express our appreciation to Bro. Neff for his labors among us during the camp and conference.

3. Be it resolved that we, the District Conference, express our appreciation to the cooks and all those who so faithfully and willingly provided entertainment during this camp and conference by a rising vote of thanks.

4. We are indeed grateful for God's blessings and presence and thank Him for the gracious victories and golden opportunities which this camp meeting has brought to everyone. Truly we can say, "God has done great things for us whereof we are glad." Praise His Name!

## Report of the District Superintendent

To the Oklahoma-Texas Conference convened at Hopeton, Oklahoma, July 25, 1949.

Greetings:

We take pleasure in giving this report. The past year has been one of victory and advancement.

There has been considerable improving on the District this year. Brother League will have when completed one of the finest church plants on the District. Oklahoma City has a new parsonage which greatly increases our outlay there. Hopeton has moved their parsonage onto a basement and added a room. This has meant work for the pastors and giving upon the part of the people.

Brother and Sister Brantly went to Dallas, Texas in December and started meetings. Souls found God. They soon felt the need of a Pilgrim Holiness church and got in touch with us. We held a revival in April and organized a new church. We welcome this church into our conference.

We have several new pastors on the District this year and welcome each of them into our midst.

There have been some good revivals on the District and new members received. Our only hope is to build around revivals. We should pray and plan for revivals. I am of the opinion that we should plan for three revivals a year.

In looking over the graphs of the last six years we find our property valuation has increased from \$16,000.00 to over \$100,000.00.

We have traveled 12,460 miles in District work, made 40 visits to the churches, held 20 board meetings, organized one church dedicated one parsonage, attended two General Board meetings, and two Board meetings at Colorado Springs.

We praise God for victory and we love His work and His people.

## Minutes of District Young People's Conference

The Third Annual Oklahoma-Texas Young People's Conference was held July 23rd at 2:00 p. m. at the Hopeton Pilgrim Holiness Church. Rev. Wm. Neff presiding.

The Song service was led by Sister Lily Slaven. Jerald Bushman led in prayer. Sister Close introduced Rev. and Mrs. Neff. A rising vote of thanks and welcome was given to Bro. Neff. Sister Neff was welcomed with a hearty "Amen" from all present. Sister Neff gave her testimony. Bro. Neff gave a brief word of exhortation.

Roll call was given by churches and one member from each church gave an informal report of the local society for the year. Eight churches were represented and their reports were accepted as given.

Lily Slaven was appointed by the District Council as District Executive Secretary for the coming year. Election of officers terminated as follows: Recording Secretary, Mary Darden; Treasurer, Frances Hofen.

5. Be it resolved that each Society set aside one meeting a quarter for study of the church doctrine.

6. Be it resolved that Labor Day be proclaimed District Young People's Day with a gathering to be held at Enid, Oklahoma.
