ASSEMBLY PROCEEDINGS

The First Annual Assembly of the Oregon Home Missionary District of the Pilgrim Holiness Church convened at the Pilgrim Holiness Church in Medford, Ore. at 9 a.m. June 18,1940, with Dist. Supt. R.D.Brown in the Chair.

The devotional service was conducted by Dr.E.P.Dixon, friend and co-laborer with Martin Wells Knapp and Rev. Seth C.Rees.After singing of two hymns, Rev.QH.Hampton, president of Spokane Pilgrim Bible School, led in prayer. Rev. E.P.Dixon read the Scripture and commented briefly on it. The District Supt. then gave us a very helpful exhortation on standing by the Word and the clean old way.

Rev. C.E.Cox, pastor of the local church, gave a word of welcome to all officers and members of the Assembly.

Rev. E.R, Himmelright, District Supt. of our Idaho and Washington, was introduced. He spoke some very encouraging words to the Assembly. It was voted that he and Bro. Hampton be given seats in the Assembly bar.

Business sessions of the Assembly set for the hours of 9:30 to 11:00 a.m. and 3 to 4 p.m. The District Supt. then appointed C.E.Cox, E.P.Dixon, and O.C.Keller to serve on the Ways and Means Committee and the Resolutions Committee.

Pastors then reported and reports were accepted. Adjourned.

Second Sitting: Called to order with the District Supt. in the Chair, A hymn was sung after which Brother R.D.Brown read the Second chapter of First John, Rev. S.G.Tighe led in prayer. Minutes of last session read and approved.

Motion made and carried that Rev. Orval C. Keller be accepted as member of the Oregon District. District officers were named: District Sect'y, C.E.Cox. District Treas. E.P.Dixon. District Trustees: C.E.Cox, E.P.Dixon, and O.C.Keller.

Motion made and carried that Curtis D. Woodruff, Sidney G. Tighe, C.L.Dage, and Delbert Scriven be accepted into the District as first year licensed ministers.

Motion made and carried that Rev. G.H. and Mrs Florence Schofield, ordained ministers, be accepted into District.

Reports heard from Escolutions Cormittee.

Ways and Means Committee reported.

Resolutions

1. Realizing the need of this new district, resolved that our District Council investigate and plan to obtain a suitable property for Headquarters, Camp and Assembly.

2. Resolved that the Dist, Council serve as our District Home Missionary Committee.

3. Resolved that each church devote one service each month to the General Missionary Interests, of both Home and Foreign work, and that an offering be taken for the same.

4. Resolved that we set aside a week-end period once a quarter for a district holiness convention for all our churches of the District, as directed by the D.S.

5. Resolved that we give no minister a place in our pulpit, unless the same come to us well recommended by those whom we trust.

6.Resolved that the D.S. appoints a Sunday School Sect'y for the District to stimulate and carry on this work.

7. In as much as we are living in days of extreme lust and worldliness and that such a spitit is present even in holiness churches, be it resolved that we request every parent member of our families that they see to it that their children do dress and conduct themselves as becameth holiness, and according to our Manual.

8. Resolved that each church give a food pounding each month to their paster. (See Manual , page 39.)

9. Resolved that all monies be sent District Treasurer by the 15th of each month.

10. Resolved that each church take an offering of food and cash for the Assembly and Campmeeting.

11. Resolved that District Books close May 31 st.

12. We wish to express our heart felt appreciation to the Medford church and pastor for their entertainment

Ways and Means Committee

1. We recommend that our church membership(where possible pay one and one half $(1\frac{1}{2}\phi)$ cents per week per member for District Budget, same to be prorated by District **G**ouncil .

2. Whereas the support of the District Supt. is inadequate, we recommend that each church take an offering for him at the time of his quarterly visits, the same to be applied on his traveling expenses.

3. We recommend that all pastors tithe to the District Treasurer and that this same be used for District Supt. support.

4. We recommend that all birthday offerings be used for Home Missions on this Oregon District.

A WORD OF APPRECIATION.

Whereas, we as a District, have been privileged to have appointed for us by the General Board of the Pilgrim Holiness Church, Rev. R.D. Brown as our District Supt., we therefore extend to the Board and to Brother Brown, a hearty vote of thanks for his labor and service in this, our first Camp and Assembly of the Oregon Dist. We promise to stand by him and pray for his success this coming Assembly year.
