Overview of WIF

Wesleyan Investment Foundation exists to assist churches and other church-related organizations of The Wesleyan Church and churches of various other denominations by providing financing at favorable rates for the purchase, construction, renovation and expansion of churches, parsonages and other buildings and property.

Rate of Return

WIF will pay a stated rate of 5.50% beginning January 1, 2024. The rate may be reset July 1, 2024 and semi-annually thereafter.

Stable Advantages:

Wesleyan Investment Foundation has been in existence since 1946 with the purpose remaining the same, “to provide loan funds to churches.” The plan offers three characteristics:

- Stability of principal — the value is not based on the stock and bond market and thus does not fluctuate according to those market forces.
- A declared interest rate — participants know in advance what the interest rate will be.
- No charges — participant may transfer assets in or out of the Wesleyan Investment Foundation Option without fees, penalty or market value adjustment from Wesleyan Investment Foundation.
